## **Materials:**


1. Four single subject marble notebooks with lines NO SPIRALS (METAL)

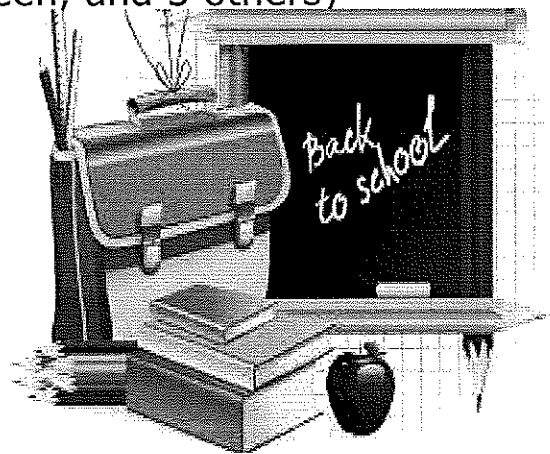

Hello Parents, Guardians, and Students!

I truly hope your summer has been going well. Students, I hope you have been keeping up on all of your reading and math skills while working on the packets that you signed for back in June. If not, please begin to do some grade-level reading and brushing up on your math facts (multiples), multiplication, division, place value, and fraction basics to help you make a smooth transition come September.

As a new school year approaches, I ask that you take a moment with your child and go over the list of supplies that they will need for the upcoming academic year. I would appreciate that your child have as much as possible or most of their supplies with them on the first day of class. In particular, the copybooks and pencils will be the most important items to bring in which will allow us to get some of the "housekeeping" out of the way. The below items can be purchased at big-chain stores such as; Wal-Mart (good deals there!), Target, Staples, and Dollar Tree. In addition, it is expected that your child come to school appropriately dressed each school day. Please consult with the district's uniform policy. **As always, no "hoodies" will be allowed in class during the day per our dress code. So please plan ahead and instead purchase a navy blue sweater for your child.** The room will cold, come September. Parents and guardians, if you are planning to celebrate your child's birthday in class, please speak with me in regards to an appropriate snack for the class.

I have included on the back of this letter, a list of my rules and expectations that EACH student WILL be held accountable for the upcoming academic year. Please go over them with your child and discuss with them the "benefits" of being a successful learner and the direct relationship they have in fostering a positive educational experience here at Colwyn. Academic ownership means: **Be on time! Be on task! Be ready to learn!**

- ~ 2 1 ½ or 2 inch plastic 3 hole binder (for organizing folders, homework, important papers, etc...)
- ~ 1 pack of binder dividers
- ~ 5 copybooks & 1 small notepad (homework)
- ~ 2 or 3 pocket folders (SRI/CDT folder, organizing papers, etc...)
- ~ packet of pencils (12 or more) and sharpener
- ~ 2 highlighters
- ~ 1 vinyl/soft pencil case
- ~ 1 ruler
- ~ 2 erasers
- ~ small box of colored pencils
- ~ 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- ~ 2 box of tissues
- ~ 1 or 2 glue sticks
