

UNIFORM DRESS CODE POLICY

All students must adhere to the dress code policy. The dress code policy assists in creating a positive and productive safe learning environment. In addition to the guidelines below students are not allowed to wear **jeans, jeggings, leggings, yoga pants, tights, sweatpants, or hoodies**. Only head garments related to religious beliefs will be acceptable.

FEMALE STUDENTS

BOTTOMS

- Khaki/Tan, black, or dark blue pants, skorts, skirts, or shorts of the appropriate size for the student (NO EXCESSIVELY BAGGY OR TIGHT BOTTOMS). No stretch or spandex type pants allowed.
- Skirts, shorts, and skorts should be no more than one inch above the knee. Note: We encourage parents to provide extra uniform bottoms and sanitary napkins in their child's locker in the case of an emergency.

TOPS

- White, gray, navy blue, or light blue polo, golf, oxford, or dress shirt – No tight shirts allowed.
- Long or short sleeves are allowed. Logos no larger than a quarter.
- All shirts must have a collar.
- Solid white, khaki/tan, gray, black, or navy blue cardigan or vest-styled sweaters are allowed. No prints or stripes.
- ALL UNDERSHIRTS (LONG OR SHORT SLEEVED) MUST BE THE SAME COLOR OF THE SHIRT WORN (WHITE OR NAVY BLUE) AND MUST BE WORN UNDER THE SHIRT.
- Bras should not be visible under white uniform shirts (no bright colors or colorful prints).
- No hoodies, fleece, sweatshirts, hats, bandanas, or scarves allowed.

FOOT APPAREL – Socks must be worn with shoes. All laces must be tied. No combat boots, steel-toed boots, slides/mules, athletic sandals, open toe shoes, sandals, slippers or flip-flops will be permitted. All shoes must be enclosed, no part of the foot should be exposed.

MALE STUDENTS

BOTTOMS

- Khaki/Tan, black, or dark blue pants or shorts of the appropriate size for the student (NO EXCESSIVELY BAGGY OR TIGHT BOTTOMS).
- Shorts should be no more than one inch above the knee.
- PANTS MUST BE WORN AT WAIST LEVEL.

TOPS

- White, gray, navy blue, or light blue polo, golf, oxford, or dress shirt.
- Long or short sleeves are allowed. Logos no larger than a quarter.
- All shirts must have a collar.
- Solid white, khaki/tan and navy blue cardigan or vest-styled sweaters are allowed. No prints or stripes.
- ALL UNDERSHIRTS (LONG OR SHORT SLEEVED) MUST BE THE SAME COLOR OF THE SHIRT WORN (WHITE OR NAVY BLUE) AND MUST BE WORN UNDER THE SHIRT.
- No hoodies, fleece, sweatshirts, hats, or scarves allowed.

FOOT APPAREL – Socks must be worn with shoes. All laces must be tied. No combat, steel-toed work boots, sandals, slides/mules, athletic sandals, open toe shoes, flip-flops or slippers will be permitted. All shoes must be enclosed, no part of the foot should be exposed.

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES OR EMERGENCIES ARE SUBJECT TO ADMINISTRATOR DISCRETION.

NOTE: Students who have clothing requirements as per religious beliefs should adhere to the school uniform policy in coordination with religious attire.

Parents are required to read the Student Handbook and Uniform Policy with their student and sign and return the Contract Form for the Uniform Dress Code Policy, included in this mailing.
