The **Penn Wood WISE** program (William Penn International Student Experience) plans trips abroad for students of Penn Wood High School every year.

In April of 2020 we will be traveling to Costa Rica for 7 days over Spring Break. We are excited to begin enrolling students on this trip. We will be holding an informational meeting on Tuesday, May 14 from 6-7pm in the library at Cypress Street, and will begin enrolling students that night. Please come to the meeting to learn more about trip details, itinerary, price and how to enroll. All students who will be attending PWHS during the 2019-2020 school year are eligible to come on the trip (this includes current 8th graders).

We will be traveling with Education First Tours, a well-established and respected organization that organizes trips for students. In 2016 Penn Wood WISE went to Spain for 8 days on an EF Tour. We visited Madrid & Barcelona, biked and walked through beaches, parks, cathedrals, museums, ancient ruins and quaint neighborhoods in each city, and even took a boat tour on the Mediterranean Sea. During Spring Break 2017 we went to Paris & the Riviera for 9 days and visited the Eiffel tower, the Louvre, Notre Dame Cathedral, Basque country, Nice, Monaco and many UNESCO world heritage sites along the way. In April of 2019 we traveled to Paris and Barcelona for 9 days.
