Again, I am really looking forward to a wonderful year!

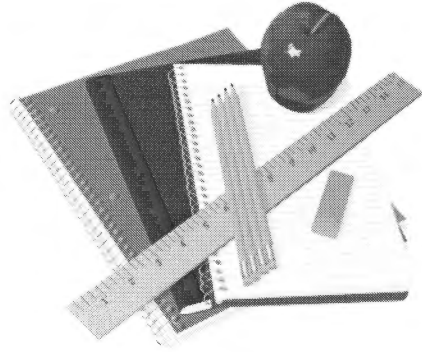

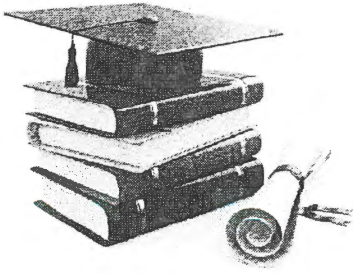
