

Penn Wood High School Dress Code

Students are expected to wear appropriate dress for school. Parents, teachers, and peers are encouraged to advise students about what is and is not appropriate. For health and safety reasons, shoes must be worn at all times in school and on school property. All students are required to wear in plain view, on the upper torso, the unobstructed school-issued picture ID card. Duplicate cards will be issued to repeat offenders at a cost of \$5.00 per card.

To clarify our expectations, a committee of Student Council and teachers compiled a list of inappropriate attire. In accordance with the school board approved code, **students will not be permitted to wear:**

- long shirts that hang (approximately) longer than the wrist
- visible underwear
- tank tops, body shirts, or spaghetti strap tops
- outfits which expose the midriff or belly
- excessively short skirts, shorts, or dresses
- skintight, sheer, torn, or “see through” garments
- short-shorts, gym or bike shorts
- tights/leggings may not be worn without a skirt, dress, or shorts of appropriate length over the tights
- hats, caps, scarves, or hoods
- clothing with obscene, profane, or inflammatory language or graphics
- flip-flops, slippers, spiked or stiletto heels
- outdoor coats (inside the building)
- any other attire deemed inappropriate by the school administration
- Inappropriately dressed students for whom a parent/guardian cannot be reached to bring appropriate clothes or grant permission to go home to change may be sent to In-School Suspension.
